North Carolina Community Colleges Linemen's Scholarships

Guidelines

The Fallen Linemen Foundation and the North Carolina Community College's Linemen Scholarship have been created to assist students interested in pursuing a career as an electrical lineman and have successfully complete a community college lineman's program. Two \$2000 scholarships will be offered to qualifying students enrolled in an Electrical Lineman Program. Currently, there are four community colleges offering qualified programs. They are:

- Caldwell Community College
- Nash Community College
- Forsyth Technical Community College Stanley
- Stanly Community College

A program director from each of the four colleges will be required to submit one applicant per college who is currently enrolled in a Lineman's Program, and who will complete the program during the current academic year. The scholarships are available to students enrolled full-time in an Electrical Lineman Program in the North Carolina Community College System.

Eligible students must:

- be a permanent resident of North Carolina;
- have a high school diploma from an accredited school or GED equivalent;
- have completed or be close to completing a Lineman's Program;
- demonstrate financial need;
- demonstrate academic performance;
- demonstrate leadership in the classroom;
- demonstrate team mentality;
- demonstrate excellent safety skills

The Fallen Lineman Foundation anticipates awarding two scholarships of \$1000 for the 2014-2015 academic year upon completion of the program.

Scholarship recipients will be selected by a committee of NC Community College's representatives. The committee will consider **financial need (40%)**, **merit (50%)**, as determined by academic and field performance; community service (10%), and **personal commitment** to the lineman's program, as determined by the required documentation.

Proceeds for the scholarship will be disbursed directly to the student.
